IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL 15511

Dear INTERNATIONAL® Customer,

This notice applies to your vehicle identified on the enclosed card. This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration and the Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Navistar has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2015 and 2016 LoneStar® and 9900 model trucks built 6 January 2014 thru 13 March 2015 with feature code 07MCJ (6" diameter stack tail pipe).

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

An incomplete weld at the flared section of the tail pipe may cause a crack in the weld which may result in partial or full separation of the tail pipe from the vertical exhaust pipe.

RISK TO MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY

If the tail pipe separates from the vertical exhaust pipe during vehicle operation, it could hit another vehicle in the roadway or land in the roadway and be hit by another vehicle which could result in property damage or personal injury.

DEFECT REMEDY

The repair will involve replacement of the tail pipes. Dealers have parts and instructions to repair your vehicle. The repair will be performed free of charge and take approximately 30 to 45 minutes to complete.

NOTE: To ensure parts availability, please contact your dealer to schedule an appointment for this repair. Doing this will allow your dealer to have the required parts on hand when you arrive and minimize downtime.

ACTIONS YOU SHOULD TAKE

If you own this vehicle, please schedule an appointment with any INTERNATIONAL® dealer to have your vehicle repaired. You can find your nearest dealer by calling 1-800-448-7825 or by using the dealer locator at <http://www.internationaltrucks.com>.

If you have already paid for repairs that corrected the defect, you may be eligible for reimbursement of certain repair expenses. Present your original repair paperwork and proof of payment to any INTERNATIONAL® dealer and your eligibility will be reviewed. You may also submit a claim using the enclosed Request for Reimbursement card.

If you are the lessor of this vehicle, please forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days to comply with federal regulations.

If you do not own this vehicle, please fill out and return mail the enclosed card so that you will not be contacted again about this recall.

IF YOU NEED FURTHER ASSISTANCE

If you believe that Navistar has failed to remedy the defect without charge or within a reasonable time, please follow the procedure described in the Owner Assistance Guide section in your Owner's Manual or call toll free 1-800-448-7825.
