## IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL 15V-532

Dear Oshkosh Vehicle Owner:

Ref: Oshkosh S-Series Front Discharge Concrete Mixers w/CNG fuel systems

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Oshkosh has decided that some Oshkosh S-Series Front Discharge Concrete Mixers with CNG fuel systems built with Emcara CNG thermal PRD valves have a defect that relates to motor vehicle safety. These vehicles were built between July 16, 2014 and June 30, 2015.

#### Why is a recall being conducted?

Some Oshkosh S-Series Front Discharge Concrete Mixer models with CNG fuel systems were built with an Emcara CNG thermal Pressure Relief Device (PRD) which may not vent properly. In the most severe case the thermal PRD may not vent at all. The purpose of the thermal PRD is to relieve pressure in the CNG system if the CNG tank is reaching an unsafe level of pressure, as might occur with a thermal event that heats up a tank. In the event of a thermal event, the thermal PRD may not vent properly which increases the likelihood of a CNG tank over-pressurizing and rupturing. A tank rupture creates an increased risk of fire and injury to the truck occupants, fire-fighters or bystanders.

#### What are we doing about the problem?

For each vehicle, Oshkosh will:

- Inspect and replace (if needed) the affected CNG thermal PRD valves, free of charge to you.
- The inspection will take approximately one hour.
- If replacement valves are required, the procedure will take from 2 to 6 hours depending on the number of valves that require replacement and the amount of CNG fuel that must be defueled first.

**What should you do?**

- The inspection & replacement of the CNG thermal PRD valves should be performed at the earliest opportunity by a Oshkosh/McNeilus representative. Oshkosh anticipates that owners will continue to place their vehicles in service until the recall actions can be completed.
