Dear Peterbilt Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Peterbilt has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain vehicles built with Eaton FR series 10 speed transmissions, manufactured between January 2, 2015 and January 9, 2015. Eaton notified Peterbilt that certain transmissions were built with an incorrect bearing spacer. In affected vehicles, the reverse gear may remain engaged after the shift lever is moved from the reverse to neutral position.

A vehicle containing this defect will move without warning when the transmission selector is in the neutral position and the clutch pedal is released. Unexpected movement can increase the risk of a crash.

<i>The problem is...</i>	Wrong bearing spacer for the FR transmission
<i>Correction...</i>	Repair or replace the transmission
<i>What you must do ...</i>	Contact your dealer immediately to schedule an appointment

Peterbilt has initiated a recall to remedy the defect free of charge. Please contact a Peterbilt dealership to schedule this repair. This repair should take approximately 5.0 hours labor, and will be performed at no charge to you. If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.


