

**Recall 15-061-MUS / NHTSA Recall # 15V-684)
(Replacement of an electrical harness for heated and remote mirrors)**



IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL NOTICE

November 2nd, 2015

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the *National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act*.

Micro Bird Corporation Inc. has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain Ford, T-Series school buses manufactured from 2015/08/24 through 2015/09/17. Our records indicate that you own vehicle(s) with the vehicle's identification number shown on the recall list.

What is the safety issue?

The diameter of the electrical wire on the passenger entrance door side is not sufficient for the amperage required for all the heated mirrors. It may cause overheating and set on fire. *Due to the serious injuries this situation may cause, we ask for the repair to be done as soon as possible following the reception of this notice.*

What are we asking you to do?

Call our after-sale service to order the recall components kit and replace the connection of the electrical harness as described in the procedure. Then return the reply sheet of each repaired vehicle to Micro Bird Corporation Inc. This will enable us to update our files and send you a reimbursement check for the labor.

How long will it take?

Reimbursement for this repair will be made for labor up to forty-five (45) minutes.
