**Subject: Porsche Safety Recall AF06 – Replacement of Low Pressure Fuel Line
2015 – 2016 Macan S
2015 – 2016 Macan Turbo**

Dear Mr. .

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Porsche has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2015 – 2016 model year Macan S and 2015 - 2016 model year Macan Turbo vehicles. Our records show that you are the owner of a vehicle affected by this action.

What is the issue?

Porsche has determined that the low pressure fuel line can begin to leak near the connection point to the fuel rail on your vehicle.

If this occurs, a small quantity of fuel can leak out at the connection point to the fuel rail and you may detect the smell of fuel. A fuel leakage in the presence of an ignition source increases the risk of a fire.

What will we do?

Porsche is conducting a safety recall on these vehicles. The low pressure fuel line in your vehicle will be replaced at your authorized Porsche dealer. Repairs are expected to take 1 hour. Of course, these repairs will be completed at no charge to you.

What should you do?

Please contact your authorized Porsche dealership to schedule a repair appointment and to arrange in advance for a Porsche loaner vehicle should you require alternate transportation during the repair period.

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Reimbursement of Expenses

If you have previously paid for repairs relating to the condition described in this letter, the enclosed form explains how to request reimbursement. We would be pleased to review your reimbursement request.

Lease vehicles and address change

If you are the lessor and registered owner of the vehicle identified in this action, the law requires you to forward this letter immediately via first-class mail to the lessee within (10) days of receipt. If you have changed your address or sold the vehicle, please fill out the enclosed prepaid Owner Reply Card and mail it to us so we can update our records.
