IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

OWNER NOTIFICATION

NHTSA RECALL 15V-733

Dear Nissan Altima Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Nissan has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in some Model Year 2015 Nissan Altima vehicles. Our records indicate that you own or lease the Nissan vehicle identified by the VIN on the inside of this notice.

Reason for Recall

The bolts that secure the brake caliper assembly to the steering knuckle may be improperly torqued on certain Model Year 2015 Nissan Altima vehicles. If a bolt is not properly tightened, it may loosen and eventually fall out. If this condition occurs and is left uncorrected over time the caliper assembly may loosen. The caliper may separate from the vehicle; potentially reducing braking performance which could lead to a crash. Although this could occur without warning, a noticeable noise or vibration from the front wheels may indicate that your vehicle is affected.

What Nissan Will Do

Your Nissan dealer will confirm the presence and torque on the front torque member bolts and torque the bolts to the correct specification at no cost to you. Please note that your Nissan dealer may require your vehicle for a longer period of time based upon their work schedule, or parts availability.

What You Should Do

Contact your Nissan dealer at your earliest convenience in order to arrange an appointment to have your vehicle inspected. **If you hear a noticeable noise or feel a vibration from the front wheels, stop driving your vehicle and contact your dealer as soon as possible to have the vehicle inspected.** Please bring this notice with you when you keep your service appointment.
