Dear Peterbilt Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Peterbilt has decided that certain model year 2015 Peterbilt model 388 vehicles manufactured from January 28, 2014, through February 03, 2014, fail to comply with the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 120, "Tire Selection and Rims for Motor Vehicles Other Than Passenger Cars." The affected vehicles were built with Michelin XZA2 295/60/R22.5 front tires and 8.25 inch wheels and were certified to a front GAWR rated greater than the maximum 12,350lbs allowed.

If the truck exceeds the load rating for the tire/wheel combination, the tire may fail prematurely, increasing the risk of a crash.

<i>The problem is...</i>	Incorrect front wheels specified
<i>Correction...</i>	Dealers will replace the 8.25" front wheels with 9.00" wheels and reprogram the engine's vehicle speed to appropriate settings dependent on GAWR
<i>What you must do ...</i>	Inspect front tires for wear and contact your dealer immediately to schedule an appointment

Peterbilt has initiated a recall to remedy the noncompliance free of charge. Please contact a Peterbilt dealership to schedule this repair. To find your nearest Peterbilt dealer, please visit Dealer Locator at www.Peterbilt.com. This repair should take approximately 1.50 hours labor, and will be performed at no charge to you. If you have had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.
