
HEADLINER REPLACEMENT






IV. BACKGROUND


FMVSS 201 specifies certain requirements for occupant protection in interior impact. A roof headliner designated for markets outside of the U.S was incorrectly used for vehicles to be distributed to Puerto Rico for first sale. Vehicles using this headliner may not meet some of the requirements of S6.2 of FMVSS 201. This can increase the risk of an injury to occupants in the event of a crash.












VI. WORK PROCEDURE

1. RECORD SEAT POSITIONS

2. REMOVE THE HEADLINER




a) Remove the rear hatch weatherstrip.



b) Apply tape as shown to protect the headliner from damage.

NOTE: The headliner will be removed and installed through the rear hatch.



c) Disengage the 6 claws and the 2 guildes to remove the rear shoulder seat belt cover.

NOTE: DO NOT pull the cover forcibly the claws could be damaged.





- No. 2 Roof Silencer Pad
- · Left and right rear side rail spacers


3. NEW HEADLINER PREPERATION

The parts in the illistration below will be reinstalled onto the new headliner.







- a) Mark the locaion of the tape that attaches the roof harness and anntenna harness to the headliner.
- b) Remove the roof harness.
- c) Remove the antenna harness.



Tesa Tape 54118 will be used to attach the harnesses to the headliner.

The tape is pre cut into 50mm x 100mm rectangles. To attach the roof harnesses to the headliner cut each rectangle into 5 equal strips.






- d) Reattach the roof harness to the new headliner as shown. (7 strips of tape needed)
- e) Reattach the antenna harness to the new headliner as shown. (12 strips of tape needed)

NOTE: Only the Tesa 54118 tape has been approved to attach the harreness to the new headliner.



f) Carefully remove the roof silencer pad.




g) Place glue dots approximately 13mm in diameter as shown onto the silencer pad.



- h) Align the pad with the markings on the headliner.
- Press down and hold for one minute until the glue sets.




j) Carefully remove both No. 5 roof silencer pads.




Hot glue gun needed

- k) Place glue dots approximately 13mm in diameter in the center of the pads.
- I) Align the No. 5 pad with the markings on the headliner.
- m) Press down and hold for one minute until the glue sets.
- n) Repeat on the other pad.



o) Carefully remove the 4 rear roof silencer pads.



Hot glue gun needed

- p) Place a drop of glue on the rear pad.
- q) Align the rear pad with the markings on the headliner.
- r) Press down and hold for one minute until the glue sets.
- s) Repeat on the other 3 pads.






