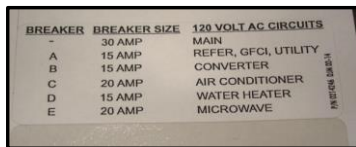

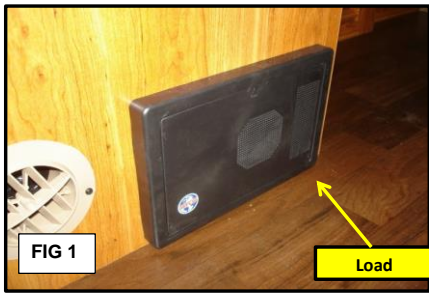

120 Volt label

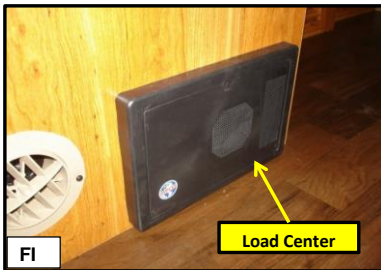


- Fig 1:** The label identifying the breakers inside the Load Center may be incorrect.
- Fig 2:** Open the Load Center. Breakers in the Load Center are 30, 15, 15, 20, 15 and 20 amps. Check the 120V label that identifies the breakers, typically found below the fan and on the door.

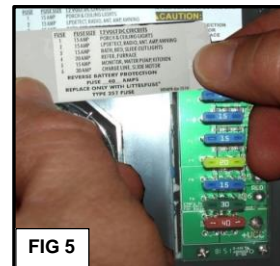
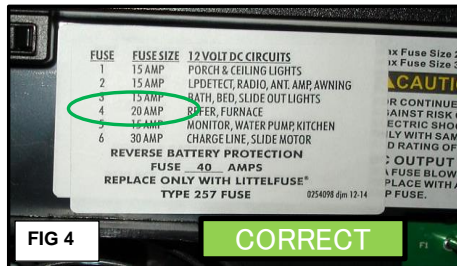
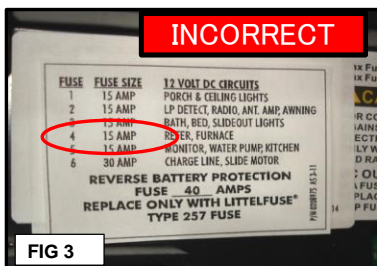


- Fig 3:** Incorrect label shows a 20 Amp for breaker D, and no value for breaker E.
- Fig 4:** Correct label shows breaker D as a 15 Amp for Water Heater, and breaker E as a 20 Amp for Microwave.
- NOTE:** Clean the area with Isopropyl alcohol and allow to dry prior to installing the new label.
- Fig 5:** Cover the old label with the new replacement label.

12 Volt label



- Fig 1:** The label identifying the fuses inside the Load Center may be incorrect.
- Fig 2:** Open the Load Center. Fuses in the Load Center are 15, 15, 15, 20, 15, 30 & 40 amps. Check the label that identifies the breakers, typically found below the fan and on the door.



- Fig 3:** Incorrect label shows a 15 amp fuse in position 4 for the refrigerator and furnace.
- Fig 4:** Correct label shows a 20 amp fuse for position 4 for the refrigerator and furnace.
- NOTE:** Clean the area with Isopropyl alcohol and allow to dry prior to installing the new label.
- Fig 5:** Cover the old label with the new replacement label.
