Dear Peterbilt Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Peterbilt has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain vehicles built with the Fontaine Ultra LT Fifth Wheel, manufactured between February 14, 2011 and December 5, 2012. The defect involves a susceptibility of the fifth wheel and its locking mechanism to cumulative damage that may cause the fifth wheel lock to function improperly or a failure of the locking mechanism to properly engage.

If the fifth wheel and locking mechanism are sufficiently damaged, the locking mechanism may fail to operate as intended and the trailer may unexpectedly detach from the tractor, increasing the risk of crash.

<i>What you must do ...</i>	Contact your dealer immediately to schedule an appointment

Peterbilt has initiated a recall to remedy the defect free of charge. Please contact a Peterbilt dealership to schedule this repair. This repair should take approximately 1.5 hours labor, and will be performed at no charge to you. If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.


