PURPOSE:

The purpose of this parts bulletin is to reinforce the correct ordering and usage of DOT-3 and DOT-4 Brake Fluid. Use of proper brake fluid will ensure proper brake system performance, help maintain vehicle safety standards, and prevent avoidable warranty claims or component failures.

CURRENT PART NUMBER INFORMATION:

MZ311987 BRAKE FLUID, DOT-3

MZ320900 BRAKE FLUID, DOT-4

Either part may be ordered based upon the specific need by the Dealer.

BACKGROUND:

Mitsubishi has manufactured and designed its vehicles to accommodate both DOT-3 and DOT-4 brake fluids. While both DOT-3 and DOT-4 allow for interchangeability in certain circumstances, Dealers are to follow the specific owner/service manuals pertaining to the particular vehicle that is being serviced.

Please note that Mitsubishi is administering one active safety recall campaign that specifically **requires DOT-4 brake fluid usage** by Dealers. Specifically, Safety Recall / SR-15-004 (NHTSA ID: 15V337) specifies that that only DOT-4 brake fluid is to be used for the remedy repair and associated with that campaign. Repair instructions for this campaign must continue to be followed as indicated.

AFFECTED VEHICLES:

All Mitsubishi vehicles utilize either DOT-3 or DOT-4 product.

Vehicles involved in Safety Recall SR-15-004 (NHTSA ID: 15V337) are identified on the SuperScreen and are referenced in Safety Bulletin SR-15-004REV. They include:

- Certain 2006 – 2009 Eclipse (4-cylinder only) vehicles built 04/20/05 – 02/13/09
- Certain 2007 – 2009 Eclipse Spyder (4-cylinder only) vehicles built 12/23/05 – 02/13/09
