Dear IC Bus Customer,

This notice applies to your vehicle identified on the enclosed card. This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

IC Bus has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2015 and 2016 CE and RE school bus models built 31 July 2014 thru 20 February 2015 with feature code 04EVK or 04EXM Haldex Life Seal rear brake chambers.

If you are the lessor of this vehicle, please forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days to comply with federal regulations.

Navistar requests your patience regarding the correction of this defect and apologizes for any inconvenience this may cause you.

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

Parking brakes that drag, or may not fully release, could potentially overheat and result in a wheel end fire which may cause property damage or personal injury.

RISK TO MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY

Parking brakes that drag, or may not fully release, could potentially overheat and result in a wheel end fire which may cause property damage or personal injury.

ACTIONS YOU SHOULD TAKE

A final remedy has been determined. Repair parts have been ordered and will be available in mid-June. When parts become available, you will be notified of additional actions you should take.

During the interim period, should your truck experience parking brakes to not fully release or drag, bring your truck to the nearest International® dealer for repair.
