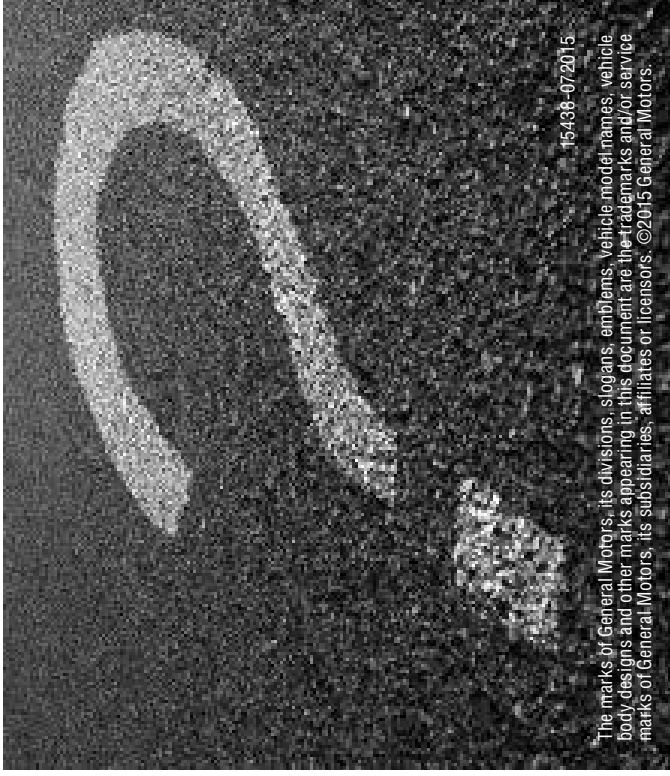

A BRIEF GUIDE TO YOUR AIRBAG SAFETY RECALL

2007 and 2008 Chevrolet Silverado and GMC Sierra 2500/3500 HD pickup trucks are affected by this recall. Answers to the most common questions are provided below.

WHY IS MY TRUCK BEING RECALLED?

GM is conducting a **safety recall to replace the front-passenger airbag inflator** in your truck. Some inflators of this type have been shown to alter over time, especially in high-humidity areas, which could lead to an inflator rupture if the airbag ever deploys. So, while **there are no known incidents of inflator rupture in Chevrolet Silverado and GMC Sierra 2500/3500 HD pickups**, we are conducting this recall as a precautionary measure.

WHEN CAN I GET THE ISSUE FIXED?

Several other carmakers are affected by similar Takata airbag issues, so it may be some time before replacement parts are available for your truck. We are working closely with the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) and our suppliers to develop parts for all affected vehicles. **As soon as parts are available, we will contact you immediately** to schedule a repair appointment.

WHAT CAN I DO IN THE MEANTIME?
