**Re: 15V320 Quarterly Reporting – Other Category**

As prescribed in Paragraph 47 of the Third Amendment to the Coordinated Remedy Order (ACRO3), and pursuant to the December 1, 2017, instructions issued by NHTSA's Recall Management Division, Honda hereby notifies NHTSA that it intends to use the "other" completion reporting category available under 49 CFR 573.7(b)(5) to account for vehicles in the Takata air bag recalls that cannot be remedied. By this notice, Honda intends to invoke the "other" completion reporting category for the following three subcategories of VINs: those deemed to be not in service under Paragraphs 45-48 of ACRO3; those associated with modules recovered from the salvage network; and those in which the owner refused to have the recall remedy applied. Each of these subcategories is described below.

**Not in Service: 237,317 VINs**

These are vehicles which are deemed to be "not in service" pursuant to Paragraphs 45-48 of ACRO3, wherein NHTSA permits manufacturers to "count vehicles in the 'other reasons' portion of their unreachable population counts" under 49 CFR 573.7(b)(5). ACRO3 ¶ 45. Under Paragraph 45 of ACRO3, vehicles proposed by Honda for not in service categorization must meet the following requirements:

- a) The vehicles are at least 5 years of age, from their production dates;
- b) The vehicles have not been registered in the last three (3) years; and
- c) Use a nationally recognized data source to corroborate that the vehicle is no longer in service.

All of the vehicles proposed by Honda for not in service treatment meet these requirements as of the date of this submission.

**Parts Recovered from Salvage: 7,401 VINs**

These are vehicles from which Honda has received, and currently retains possession of, the factory installed airbag module. These airbag modules were retrieved as a result of Honda's efforts to engage salvage yards.

**Affirmative Refusal: 11 VINs**

These are vehicles with owners that, in response to Honda's outreach efforts, have affirmatively and unequivocally communicated that they do not want to take part in the recall or receive the recall remedy.
