Chronology:

On January 14, 2016, the subject condition was identified during a routine quality check at a Vehicle Processing Center (VPC). Hyundai and the supplier initiated an investigation into the incident. On February 2, 2016, Hyundai stopped installation of the tow hitch accessory at its VPCs as well as dealer sales of the accessory hitch. Subsequent investigation revealed a potential incompatibility between the tow hitch harness control module and the vehicle's power supply circuitry. The 2016 Model Year Tucson is a new platform; this issue does not affect prior model year vehicles.

On March 1, 2016, based on the information presented to the Technical Committee, Hyundai decided to conduct a compliance recall on the affected vehicles.
