#### **Description of Defect :**

Description of the Defect :	In certain vehicles, the tire pressure monitoring system (TPMS) has been incorrectly programmed to a lower pressure than required. Because of this, the warning for tire pressure loss will be delayed, and could result in the driver not being aware that one or more tires are low.
	Additionally, the tire pressures printed on the Safety Certification label in certain vehicles are incorrect. This makes the label non-compliant with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards.
FMVSS 1 :	138 - Tire pressure monitoring systems
FMVSS 2 :	NR
Description of the Safety Risk :	Driving with too low tire pressure may cause tire failure and a loss of vehicle control, increasing the risk of a crash.
Description of the Cause :	Due to a supplementary offer of 21" rims, tire control tables were inaccurately updated to reflect the new rim size by human error. In consequence, TMPS (tire pressure monitoring system) settings and certification labels were incorrectly defined.

On February 18, 2016 Volkswagen was informed about a customer complaint from the US market about incorrectly programmed pressure values in the TPMS.

During March the complaint was analyzed and tracked to incorrect control tables and the additional mistake on the certification label was discovered.

On April 15, 2016 the matter was brought to Volkswagen's product safety committee and a determination of non-compliance with FMVSS138 was made.
