Description of the Noncompliance : It has been decided that the vehicles in this recall population fail to conform to the requirements of Part 567, "Certification." The vehicles subject to this recall may have been manufactured with the incorrect information on the Federal Identification Tag and Tire and Loading Information Label. In addition the load range of the tires installed may be different.

Description of the Cause : Production installed tires with different load ranges.
