Description of the Safety Risk: Unintentional movement of the driver's seat may affect the driver's ability to

control the vehicle increasing the risk of a crash.

Description of the Cause: The microswitch within power seat switch is designed to be sealed from

environmental factors (moisture), and if the switch is exposed to the environment, intermittent shorting of the switch's contacts can occur. It is believed production variances during manufacturing of the switch resulted in environmental exposure to the microswitch and the symptoms observed in the

field.

Chronology:

In April of 2016, Hyundai began to investigate customer reports of the power driver seat moving without driver input on Azera vehicles. A review of warranty records revealed an increase in claims for the vehicles built in the months of March through August of 2007. Incident field parts were collected from May through July of 2016 and returned to Hyundai Motor Company for testing and verification of the symptoms.

Hyundai Motor Company's review finished in August, 2016 and indicated that the claims were likely related to the cause listed above. On August 22, 2016 Hyundai made the determination to proceed with a safety recall campaign to replace the driver's power-adjustable seat switch on Model Year 2007 and 2008 Hyundai Azera vehicles produced beginning on March 07, 2007 through August 14, 2007.

Hyundai is not aware of any accidents or injuries related to this condition.

Description of Remedy:

Description of Remedy Program: Hyundai Motor America plans to notify owners of affected vehicles to

return their vehicles to their Hyundai dealers to replace the driver's power-adjustable seat switch. This procedure will be performed at no

charge.

Hyundai will provide reimbursement to owners for repairs according to
