Description of the Defect : According to the product supplier (Bendix), the Bendix SR-5 trailer spring brake valve can leak under a combination of a unique set of circumstances. Please refer to recall 16E045 for more details.

Description of the Safety Risk : If the trailer is uncoupled to a tractor. If a high rate of leakage is observed from the supply gladhand or park control valve exhaust, it is possible that the spring brakes will be slow to apply on the trailer, increasing the risk of a crash.

Description of the Cause : The valves supplied by Bendix may contain Defects

Identification of Any Warning that can Occur : The leak is heard or observed from the supply (Red) gladhand when uncoupled from the tractor.

Description of Remedy Program : Bendix will remedy the defect of the impacted valves with a permanent remedy repair kit-Bendix part number K140496.

How Remedy Component Differs from Recalled Component : Once the reparation is applied on the valve, a green or black tie wrap will be fasten to the valve.
