Revised New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – S15032416R

NOTE: The involved vehicle model years have been updated.

FCA US LLC (“FCA US”) announced a safety recall on 2007 and 2008 model year (ZH) Chrysler Crossfire vehicles.

Some of the above vehicles may have been built with a driver airbag inflator that may rupture when deploying during a crash. The potential for such ruptures may occur in some of the subject airbag inflators after several years of exposure to persistent conditions of high absolute humidity. In the event of a driver airbag inflator rupture, metal fragments could pass through the airbag cushion material, which may result in additional injury or death to vehicle occupants.

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall. A permanent remedy has not been determined at this time.

Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established methods used in the past.

We ask that you please take the time to ensure that your personnel are aware of this communication and are prepared to execute a customer friendly process for inquiries on involved vehicles.
