New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – S26051116

FCA US LLC (“FCA US”) announced a safety recall on certain 2013 through 2016 model year (FF) Fiat 500e vehicles.

Some of the above vehicles may have been built with Power Inverter Module (PIM) diagnostic software that is overly sensitive. During normal vehicle operation, the PIM may falsely diagnose an over-voltage condition in the ground circuit setting Diagnostic Trouble Codes (DTC’s) PA1EE and/or P0A1B. The consequence of setting these DTC’s is a loss of motive power. This could cause a crash without warning.

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to reprogram the PIM with new diagnostic software.

Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established methods used in the past.

We ask that you please take the time to ensure that your personnel are aware of this communication and are prepared to execute a customer friendly process for inquiries on involved vehicles.
