Keystone RV Company has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model 2016-2017 Summerland Models 1700FQ ,1750RD, 1800BH. As a result, Keystone RV is conducting a safety recall.

***Reason for
this recall***

It has been decided the vehicles in this recall population may have been manufactured with tires rated for 1870 lbs. (load range C) instead of tires rated for 2200 lbs. (load range D). An overloaded tire leads to an increased risk of tire failure, property damage and/or vehicle crash. The vehicles included in the recall are:
