Front Passenger Air Bag Inflator

Models: 2009 Pontiac Vibe

To: All General Motors Dealers

General Motors is releasing Safety Recall 15826 today. The total number of 2009 model year U.S. vehicles involved is 15,638. Please see the attached bulletin for details.

On July 15, 2016, all GM dealers were notified that the Takata front passenger air bag inflator recall was being expanded to include all 2009-2010 model year Pontiac Vibe vehicles. All involved vehicle owners of record were also advised at that time. Due to a limited supply of the parts needed to complete this recall, only the 2009 model year Pontiac Vibes are eligible for repair at this time. Letters requesting these vehicle owners to contact their dealer to arrange a service appointment for this repair will be mailed on March 31, 2017. As additional parts become available, this bulletin will be revised to include the 2010 model year Pontiac Vibes and those vehicle owners will be notified.

**Customer Letter Mailing**

The customer letter mailing for the 2009 model year Pontiac Vibes will begin on March 31, 2017.

**Global Warranty Management (GWM)**

The Investigate Vehicle History (IVH) screen in the GWM system will be updated to an "Open" status for the 2009 model year Pontiac Vibes on March 27, 2017. The status of the 2010 model year Vibes will remain as "Incomplete – Remedy not yet available" and dealers should not attempt to repair these vehicles at this time.
