

Front Passenger's Airbag Inflator and Inflator Harness Installation Tips

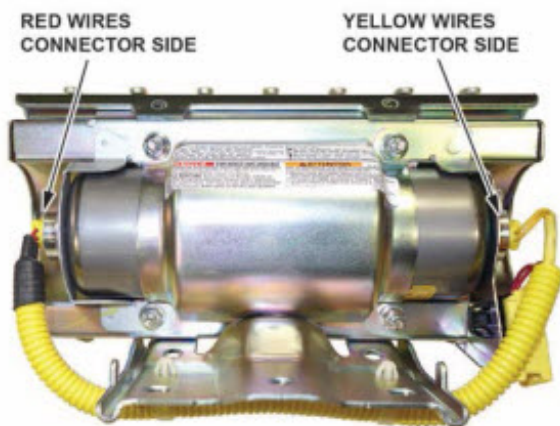
AFFECTED VEHICLES

2009–11 TSX, 2011 TSX Sport Wagon, and 2010–11 ZDX

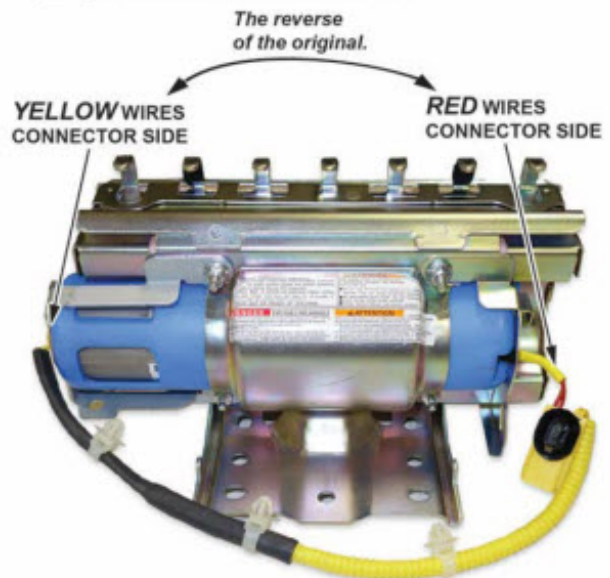
The latest replacement front passenger's airbag inflator (it's the one with blue or green collars, depending on the application) is similar but **not** the same as the original. As you can see, on the TSX and TSX Sport Wagon, the **red** and **yellow** wires now connect on the **opposite** sides of the inflator, which can be a bit confusing. On the ZDX, the connections remain the same.

With that in mind, here are some tips to help ensure a trouble-free installation:

- Make sure you're using the right airbag inflator kit part number for the vehicle you're working on.
- When connecting the inflator harness to the inflator, be sure to follow the service bulletin instructions and illustrations **to the letter**.
- Keep in mind the inflator harness connections at the inflator are **one-shot only**. You **must** do it right the **first** time!
- As you connect the inflator harness, make sure the 4-pin connector that plugs into the vehicle is on the **same** side of the airbag as the original. If it's not, the harness **won't** reach and you **won't** be able to install the airbag.
