UPDATE: Takata Recalls Front Passenger Air Bag Inflator Owner Notification

As we work through the Takata recall process, we will continue to mail owner notification and re-notification letters to urge additional customers to schedule an appointment for the repair. This notification process is being prioritized in phases, based on parts supply, age of the inflator in the vehicle (oldest first), and geographic registration history of the vehicle.

The next phase of these owner notification letters will be mailed today for the following affected vehicles:

Initial Notifications of Parts Availability (approximately 49,000):

2012 MY Forester (TKA17 – Zone A)
2008-2009 MY Impreza and WRX (TKB17 & TKC17 – Zones B & C)
2006-2007 MY Impreza and WRX (TKC17 – Zone C)
2005-2006 MY Baja (TKC17 – Zone C)

Renotifications:

2003-2006 MY Baja (TKB16 & TKC16)
2009 MY Forester (TKA16)
2006-2009 Impreza and WRX (TKA16)
2003-2004 MY Legacy and Outback (TKB16 & TKC16)

Affected VIN lists have been distributed to each Region/Zone Office, which include the latest owner registration data for all open Takata recalls, for which the customer has been notified that parts are available.
