Subject: Advance Notice – Safety Recall 60C3 – Sunroof

Audi has notified NHTSA and Transport Canada about the upcoming safety recall described in this letter.

CODE	60C3 On or about July 06, 2016 affected vehicles will be identified in ELSA and VIN lookup with the status REPAIR NOT YET AVAILABLE.
AFFECTED VEHICLES	USA: 2007-2009 MY Audi A8/S8 Canada: 2008-2009 MY Audi A8/S8
RECALL DESCRIPTION	Due to an issue during sunroof production, the process to adhere the sunroof glass to the sunroof frame was not performed to specifications. Because of this, over time the adhesive can delaminate from the glass, resulting in glass detachment from the sunroof frame. If the glass were to detach from the sunroof frame, it could become airborne while the vehicle is moving and become a road hazard, posing a risk of crash and property damage to other vehicles on the road and also pose a risk of injury to people outside of the vehicle.
CORRECTIVE ACTION	The sunroof glass assembly in potentially affected vehicles will have additional adhesive applied between the sunroof glass frame and sunroof glass panel. Repair information will be provided to dealers when parts and repair instructions become available to support this recall.

IMPORTANT REMINDER ON VEHICLES AFFECTED BY SAFETY & COMPLIANCE RECALLS

New Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: It is a violation of Federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied. By law, dealers must correct, prior to delivery for sale or lease, any vehicle that fails to comply with an applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard or that contains a defect relating to motor vehicle safety.

Pre-Owned Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: Dealers should not deliver any pre-owned vehicles in their inventory which are involved in a safety or compliance recall until the defect has been remedied.
