Parts are not currently available for this repair, however; the attached bulletin provides an inspection procedure that can be immediately performed to determine if the subject condition exists. For vehicles that pass the inspection, dealers should submit a warranty transaction using the labor code provided in the bulletin. Doing so will close the recall and make the vehicle available for sale/delivery to a customer. For vehicles that fail the inspection, dealers should not submit the inspection labor code for payment. These vehicles must be held and not delivered to customers, dealer-traded, released to auction, used for demonstration purposes or any other dealer use.

When parts are available, a revised bulletin will be released containing all of the information needed to complete the required repair. Also included will be another labor code that's covers both the inspection and repair procedures. When the required repair has been completed, dealers should submit a warranty transaction using this labor code to close the recall and make the vehicle available for sale/delivery to a customer.
