Re: **STOP SALE NOTICE**

Dear Honda Dealer:

Honda is announcing a STOP SALE NOTICE of model year 2015 through 2016 CBR300R and CB300F motorcycles to repair a potentially defective crankshaft on affected vehicles. If the connecting rod bearing retainer breaks, the engine may stall and/or not restart. An engine that stalls while riding increases the risk of a crash.

**Effective immediately, YOU MUST NOT SELL any 2015 through 2016 CBR300R and CB300F motorcycle until it has been repaired according to Service Bulletin CBR300R/CB300F #1.**

#### AFFECTED UNITS

All 2015-2016 CBR300R and CB300F motorcycles:

- *iN eResponsibility Report* will show the affected units in your dealership's inventory (available July 7).
- To determine if a specific VIN is affected, use *iN Unit Information* (available July 7).

#### SERVICE BULLETIN

*Service Bulletin CBR300R/CB300F #1*, which includes the repair procedure, parts information, as well as warranty claim information, is forthcoming.

#### CUSTOMER NOTIFICATION

AHM intends to mail notification letters to owners of affected vehicles by late August, 2016.
