IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL
NHTSA Recall Campaign # 16V-561

Dear Valued Jayco Dealer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Jayco has decided that certain Model Year 2016-2017 Alante and Precept Class A motorhomes contain a driver and passenger seat installed on a seat base that was torqued incorrectly by the seat base manufacture. After a period of time, the seat base nut may loosen and the seat may detach from the seat base. If the seat would detach when the motorhome is in transit, the operator could lose control of the unit which could result in a crash with personal injury and or property damage.

The recall remedy is to install a jam nut on top of the seat base nut for the driver and passenger seat and torque to 55 ft. lbs.

Our records show the following unit is affected by this recall and is currently part of the inventory at your dealership and requires the Recall Repair prior to being sold:
