RE: SAFETY RECALL NOTICE – Waterous Company Split-Shaft-Transmission Shift Unit Clevis Pin Dated July 21, 2016, NHTSA File 16E059

Dear Mr. (Last Name):

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Seagrave Fire Apparatus LLC has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists on your Seagrave Marauder II Fire Truck. This recall is being conducted based on the following information from Waterous Company.

Waterous Company determined that a potential noncompliance with Federal Motor Vehicle Standard (FMVSS) 102 exists in certain model C20 and C21 split-shaft transmissions and model TC20 and TC21 PTO. split-shaft transmissions manufactured from April 9, 2015, to April 20, 2016.

**Description of Defect**

The Split-Shaft-Transmission’s shift unit clevis pin could become dislodged from the transmission linkage. This condition could potentially result in the inability to shift the apparatus from road to pump mode.

The Waterous Company Split-Shaft-Transmission on the below listed vehicles are suspect of containing the recalled shift unit clevis pin. Please make an appointment at your earliest convenience with your local Seagrave Authorized Service Provider to perform the needed remedy. The remedy will be performed on a no cost basis to you. The remedy consists of removing the shift unit assembly in the affected split-shaft transmissions and replacing the shift unit's clevis pin and retaining rings with a shoulder bolt and locking nut.
