New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – S69091616

FCA US LLC (“FCA US”) announced a safety recall on certain 2016 (FF) Fiat 500 vehicles.

Some of the above vehicles may have the incorrect spare tire inflation pressure on the tire placard. The incorrect compact spare tire inflation pressure (46 psi) exceeds the maximum permissible pressure listed on the sidewall of tire (41 psi).

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to place an overlay onto the existing tire placard with the correct recommended spare tire inflation pressure.

The condition described above does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) 571.110 S4.3.4 Tire selection and rims and motor home/recreation vehicle trailer load carrying capacity information for motor vehicles with a GVWR of 4,536 kilograms (10,000 pounds) or less, which states, “No inflation pressure other than the maximum permissible inflation pressure may be shown on the placard and, if any, tire inflation pressure label unless (a) It is less than the maximum permissible inflation pressure.”

Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established methods used in the past.
