New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – S61091616

FCA US LLC (“FCA US”) announced a safety recall on certain:

- 2010 model year (JS) Chrysler Sebring
- 2011 - 2014 model year (JS) Chrysler 200
- 2010 - 2014 model year (JS) Dodge Avenger
- 2010 - 2012 model year (PM) Dodge Caliber
- 2010 - 2014 model year (MK) Jeep® Compass and Patriot vehicles.

The above vehicles may experience loss of air bag and seat belt pretensioner deployment capability in certain crash events due to a shorting condition resulting in a negative voltage transient that travels to the Occupant Restraint Controller (“ORC”) via the front impact sensor wires. The potential loss of air bag and seat belt pretensioner deployment capability in such crash events may increase the risk of injury in a crash.

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall. A permanent remedy has not been determined at this time.

Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established methods used in the past.

We ask that you please take the time to ensure that your personnel are aware of this communication and are prepared to execute a customer friendly process for inquiries on involved vehicles.
