Subject: Stop Sale / Stop Delivery for Safety Recalls 0116I and 0216I

On 9/21/16, Mazda Motor Corporation filed safety defect reports with the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) for fuel tank safety concerns on certain Mazda3 vehicles. Mazda has assigned Safety Recalls 01161 and 02161:

- Under Safety Recall 0116I, the inlet check valve on the subject vehicles may not be properly welded to the fuel tank. In the worst case, fuel may leak from the welded area.
- Under Safety Recall 0216I, the recirculation pipe may not be properly welded to the fuel tank. In the worst case, fuel may leak from the welded area.

## Action Required:

Beginning today, affected vehicles in dealer inventory must not be delivered to customers until the recall repair is completed. A list of affected VINs currently in dealer inventory has been posted on MS3. Once the affected vehicles in dealer inventory are repaired or pass inspection, retail delivery may resume. An inspection procedure is under development to confirm whether the fuel tank has the above defects.
