Subject: Safety Recall, SC0405, Goodyear Tire Recall

Summary:

Description of Defect:

On certain vehicles outfitted with Goodyear G399A LHS 295/75R22.5 LRG tires, the tires may not have been cured properly during manufacturing. This could cause the tires to have incomplete adhesion, which could lead to partial tread separation and/or tire failure.

If the tread were to separate while a vehicle is in motion, it could cause a loss of vehicle control, which would increase the risk of a crash causing injury and/or damage to property.

Models/ Model Years Affected:

Mack: Certain 2017 Pinnacle (CXU) and (CHU) model trucks manufactured from January 24, 2016 through May 28, 2016.

Vehicle Quantities:

Mack: 67 vehicles (57 U.S., and 10 Canada)

Dealer's Responsibility:

The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Act requires dealers to ensure that all new and used vehicles are free of safety defects and comply with all relevant safety standards at the time of delivery to the consumer.

Dealers should make their personnel aware of the safety recall. In the event that a dealer has a vehicle included in the safety recall in their inventory to be sold, the condition must be corrected before releasing it to a customer.

Release Schedule:

- Vehicle will be posted on the Trucks Dealer Portal October 11, 2016.
- Tires will be inspected and replaced if necessary by an authorized Goodyear Commercial Tire & Service Center or Goodyear dealer.
- Owner Notices are scheduled to be mailed on or before October 31, 2016.
