New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – S83120216

FCA US LLC (“FCA US”) announced a safety recall on certain 2016 model year (PF) Dodge Dart vehicles.

Some of the above vehicles may produce a “voltage spike” in the front windshield wiper electrical circuit when the front windshield washer pump is activated. This “voltage spike” could overload the Body Control Module (BCM) front windshield wiper electrical circuit and cause a loss of front windshield wiper function. A loss of front windshield wiper function, under certain driving conditions, could impair the driver’s vision and cause a crash without warning.

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to replace the front windshield washer pump on all involved vehicles. If the front windshield wiper electrical circuit in the BCM is inoperative, the BCM will also be replaced.

VINs identified as being involved in this campaign are currently live and searchable under Recall S83.

Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established methods used in the past. **Remedy communication is estimated to be available in late December 2016 or early January 2017.**

We ask that you please take the time to ensure that your personnel are aware of this communication and are prepared to execute a customer friendly process for inquiries on involved vehicles.
