Subject: Upcoming Safety Recall 16126
Incorrect Convertible Roof Control Module

Models: 2016 Buick Cascada

To: All General Motors Dealers

General Motors has notified the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) about an upcoming safety recall that involves certain 2016 model year Buick Cascada vehicles. A total of 4 vehicles are involved in this recall. The GM recall number is 16126.

In these vehicles, the original convertible roof control module (CRCM) was replaced during service with an incorrect control module intended only for European Cascada vehicles. The European replacement module allows the vehicle windows to close automatically or remotely in ways that do not meet all the requirements of FMVSS 118, which may increase the risk of injury from unexpected closure.

Parts are not currently available, but when parts are available, dealers are to replace the convertible roof control module with the correct module and program it.

This is a courtesy notification to dealers. Dealers will be advised when the bulletin is released.

The Investigate Vehicle History (IVH) screen in the Global Warranty Management (GWM) system will be updated for this upcoming recall on November 18, 2016. This action is being taken to assist dealers with determining which vehicles are involved so they can properly respond to customer inquiries.

Until the recall bulletin is released, the IVH screen in GWM will display "N/A" under Release Date and "Incomplete – Remedy not yet available" under Status. This means the required repair is not yet available and dealers should not attempt to perform any repairs.
