IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL
NHTSA Recall Campaign # 16V-905

Dear Valued Jayco Dealer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Jayco has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain Model Year 2016 Alante and Precept Class A motor homes manufactured August 10, 2015 through March 15, 2016. Incorrect routing of the entrance step wires, may allow them to be pinched by the sharp edge of the door threshold, creating a ground connection that could activate the step to retract on its own.

In the event that the step would retract on its own, personal injury may occur to anyone exiting the motorhome. The recall remedy is to inspect the step wiring for proper placement and if incorrect, the step will be rewired. All Recall documents are available under the Service and Parts tab on Jayco Partners.

Our records show the following unit is affected by this recall and is currently part of the inventory at your dealership and requires the Recall repair ***prior to being sold***:
