Dear Valued Customer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Pirelli has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain Pirelli P Zero All Season tires, in size 275/40R19 TL 101W (MGT) (Part Number 2535200), which may have a structural integrity issue. Pirelli is conducting a recall to address this non-conformity. Our records indicate that you have these tires on your car. Please review this letter carefully to determine whether your tires are affected and, if so, what actions to take.

WHAT IS THE PROBLEM?

Due to a production error, Pirelli P Zero All Season tires, size 275/40R19 TL 101W (MGT) (Part Number 2535200) produced during a certain production period may develop cracking in the lower sidewall area as the tire reaches the end of its tread life. If the cracking remains undetected, it could ultimately lead to an air loss and potential loss of control of the car.

WHAT SHOULD YOU DO?

To determine if your tires are affected, you need to look at the Tire Identification Number, which is on the lower sidewall after the letters "DOT". It will start with XBY2 U352. If the 4 digits after that are in the range of 0216 to 4316, then your tires are part of this recall.

If you own a Pirelli P ZeroAll Season tire, size 275/40R19 TL 101W (MGT) tire with a date code in the affected period, please contact your Maserati dealer or Pirelli tire dealer. Pirelli will provide a replacement tire free of charge, including mounting and balancing
