



IMPORTANT NON-COMPLIANCE RECALL NOTICE

This notice applies to your vehicle 5BWUV323091000032

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Vintage Trailers Ltd. has decided that certain model year 2009-2016 Intimidator, Aero, Outlaw, Bandit, and Crystal SS triple axle trailers manufactured May 9, 2008, to September 23, 2015, fail to conform to the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 120. "Wheels and Rim- Other than Passenger Cars."

! IMPORTANT !

Your Trailer is being recalled

You should attach the enclosed new Federal Identification Sticker

Why is a recall being conducted?

The Federal Identification Sticker was printed incorrectly at the time of manufacture for trailers that have triple axles with ST225/75 R15 tires with an inflation pressure of 65psi. The correct Gross Axle Weight Rating (GAWR) should have been printed as 5,080 pounds. The Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR) is correct. It is only the GAWR that had the clerical error. If the operator overloads the trailer past the 15,200 pound gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) limit, axle failure may occur, increasing the risk of a crash.

What are we doing about the problem?

We have included with this letter a new Federal Identification sticker with the printing error corrected free of charge.

What should you do?

Clean the area where the current Federal Identification Sticker is on your trailer (drivers side of the trailer, lower front corner) and apply the new sticker over the old sticker. DO NOT remove the old sticker. Apply the new sticker over the old sticker.

What if you no longer own this trailer?



Federal law required any lessor who receives a notification of a determination of a safety-related defect or noncompliance pertaining to any leased motor vehicle shall send the notice to the lessee within 10 days.

We apologize for any inconvenience this non-compliance recall may have caused.
