IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

Subject: TBB GM Minotour Body Control Modules

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Daimler Trucks North America LLC, on behalf of its wholly owned subsidiary, Thomas Built Buses, has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists on certain Minotour model buses with GM chassis manufactured October 26, 2010, through December 14, 2015.

On certain vehicles the body control module may fail, leading to intermittent function or loss of exterior vehicle lighting and/or windshield wipers. Loss of exterior lighting or windshield wipers in certain traffic conditions may increase the potential of a vehicle crash.

The wiring to the body control module will be modified as necessary. Parts are expected to be available by April 30, 2016, and repairs will begin as soon as parts are on hand.

Thomas will remedy this defect without charge. The repair should take approximately an hour, and will be performed at no charge to you. To locate a dealer please go to www.thomasbus.com.

You may be liable for any progressive damage that results from your failure to complete the Recall within a reasonable time after receiving notification.

If you do not own the vehicle that corresponds to the identification number(s) which appears on the Recall Notification, please return the notification to the Warranty Department with any information you can furnish that will assist us in locating the present owner. If you have leased this vehicle, Federal law requires that you forward this notice to the lessee within 10 days.

If you have paid to have this recall condition corrected prior to this notice, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement. For further information, please contact the Warranty Department at the number below.
