



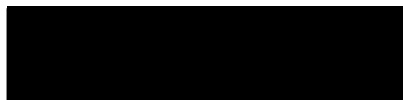

- ❖ Please be advised that your 2012-2016 Model Year FEC52, FEC72, FEC92, or FGB72 truck referenced by VIN below is open for a safety recall related to a potential short circuit of the optional accessory PCV pipe heater wiring.
- ❖ MFTA urges that you schedule an appointment with an Authorized Dealer or Parts and Service Center to perform the recall, at no charge to you, as soon as possible.

Dear Mitsubishi Fuso Truck Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Mitsubishi Fuso Truck of America, Inc. has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in the PCV pipe heater wiring on optional accessory PCV heater kits manufactured between October 1, 2015 and December 31, 2015 and installed on certain 2012 - 2016 model year FEC52, FEC72, FEC92, and FGB72 Mitsubishi Fuso trucks. Vehicles with this affected accessory kit installed might have a risk that the PCV pipe heater wiring interacts with a metal clamp used on the PCV which in turn could lead to a short circuit. This is safety relevant issue due to a potential risk of fire, though MFTBC is unaware of any fires having occurred in the field.



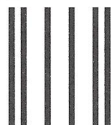

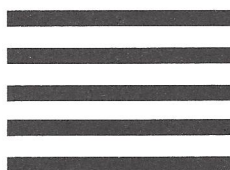
