This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. KME has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model year 2012-2014 Predator – Severe Service emergency vehicles manufactured from March, 2011, through April, 2014.

Why is a recall being conducted?

The cab door latch retaining hardware may have loosened. This condition could prevent the door from properly closing, allowing the cab door to open, without warning, while the vehicle is in motion and increasing the risk of occupant injury or crash.

What are we doing about the problem?

KME will repair your vehicle free of charge. The cab door latch hardware will be inspected for proper installation; any hardware found to be improperly tightened will be replaced. The inspection\ repair process will take approximately four hours.

What should you do?

Please contact your local dealer in order to make arrangements to have your vehicle scheduled for inspection.

What if you no longer own this vehicle?

If you are not the current owner of the vehicle, please indicate this to us by completing the attached form, and faxing or e-mailing it to KME as indicated on the form.
