Dear Volkswagen Owner,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Volkswagen has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain 2016 model year Volkswagen Golf R vehicles. Our records show that you are the owner of a vehicle affected by this action.

What is the issue? The rear axle weight limit shown on the safety certification label is incorrectly

specified as **1234 lbs**. The correct value should read **2227 lbs**. Incorrect/implausible weight information could lead to overloading of the vehicle, as the customer may ignore the low value and is not able to determine the correct maximum load. Overloading a vehicle could lead to vehicle instability

and may contribute to loss of vehicle control and result in a crash.

What will we do?

To help correct this issue, your authorized Volkswagen dealer will install a corrected label. This work will take less than one hour to complete and will be

performed for you free of charge.

What should you do? Please contact your authorized Volkswagen dealer without delay to schedule this recall repair. Please keep in mind that your dealer may need additional time

Precautions you should

take

Affected vehicles can continue to be driven as usual, but until this recall repair has been performed, do not rely on the rear axle weight limit shown on the safety certification label; *if the weight printed on the label reads 1234 lbs, it* 

is incorrect.

Lease vehicles and address changes

If you are the lessor and registered owner of the vehicle identified in this action, the law requires you to forward this letter immediately via first-class mail to the lessee within ten (10) days of receipt. If you have changed your address or sold the vehicle, please fill out the enclosed prepaid Owner Reply card and mail it to us so we can update our records.
