Your Vehicle Identification Number (VIN):

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Ford Motor Company has decided that your vehicle, with the VIN shown above, fails to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) 126: Electronic Stability Control Systems.

We apologize for this situation and want to assure you that, with your assistance, we will correct this condition. Our commitment, together with your dealer, is to provide you with the highest level of service and support.

What is the issue?

The hydraulic control unit (HCU) on your vehicle may contain debris from the manufacturing process, which can degrade the performance of electronic stability control and related systems* without warning, potentially resulting in rear wheel lock up while braking. This could result in a loss of vehicle control, increasing the risk of crash.

*These systems include, but are not limited to, anti-lock brakes, rollover protection, automatic braking, and traction control.

NOTE: Parts are expected to be available to repair your vehicle the week of September 5, 2016.

What will Ford and your dealer do?

Ford Motor Company has authorized your dealer to replace your vehicle's HCU free of charge (parts and labor).

How long will it take?

The time needed for this repair is less than one-half day. However, due to service scheduling requirements, your dealer may need your vehicle for a longer period of time.

What should you do?

Please call your dealer to request service for Recall 16C10 <u>beginning the week of September 5, 2016</u>. Provide the dealer with your VIN, which is printed near your name at the beginning of this letter.

www.Fordowner.com for dealer addresses, maps, and driving instructions.

What should you do? (continued)

Ford Motor Company wants you to have this recall completed on your vehicle. The vehicle owner is responsible for making arrangements to have the work completed.

Please note: Federal law requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.

Your vehicle may be equipped with a diagnostic feature called the Vehicle Health Report which can inform you about all available recalls, as well as other key vehicle health information. Please see https://owner.ford.com/vehicle-health for more information.

Do you need a rental vehicle?

Your dealer is authorized to provide a rental vehicle for your personal transportation at no charge (except for fuel and insurance) while your vehicle is at the dealership for repairs. Please see your dealer for guidelines and limitations.

What if you no longer own this vehicle?

If you no longer own this vehicle, and have an address for the current owner, please forward this letter to the new owner.

You received this notice because government regulations require that notification be sent to the last known owner of record. Our records are based primarily on state registration and title data, which indicate that you are the current owner.

Can we assist you further?

If you have difficulties getting your vehicle repaired promptly and without charge, please contact your dealership's Service Manager for assistance.
