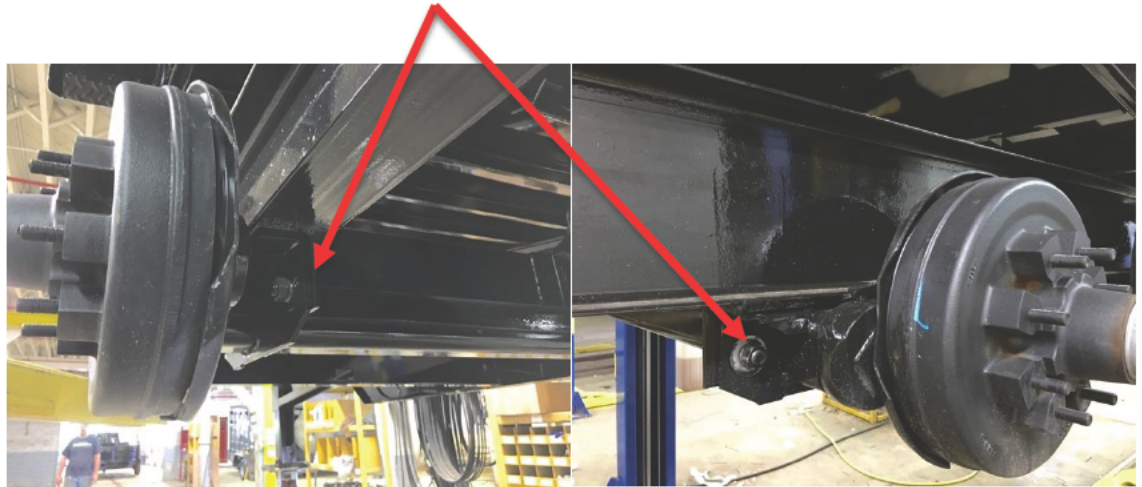
Dear Customer,

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Moritz International Inc. has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety may exist in certain 2015 and 2016 Moritz Trailers manufactured between March 2015 and June 19, 2016.

Why is the trailer being recalled?

The possibility of insufficient torque on the axle side mount brackets could result in the axle shifting or detaching creating an unsafe scenario for towing and increasing the risk of a crash.

BOLTS THAT MAY BE LOOSE



Please perform a visual inspection of your trailer. If any of the bolts indicated in the picture are missing from your trailer or the nuts are loose, do not tow the trailer. Contact us immediately at 419-526-5222 fax: 419-526-9559 email: recall@moritzint.com. If you don't find missing or loose bolts the trailer is to be taken to your dealer for inspection and repair.

What are we doing about the problem?

Moritz International is working with the supplier of the defective component, Industrial Axle Company (IAC) to make sure that your local Dealer, has the tools necessary to inspect and apply the proper torque.

The inspection and remedy are completely free of charge. Should this repair already be completed prior to this notification, you may be eligible for reimbursement of any repair costs corresponding to this corrective action. A request for reimbursement may be submitted in writing to Moritz International Inc. Customer Service 665 North Main Street, Mansfield, OH 44902 or by Email to recall@moritzinc.com, Subject: Reimbursement Request, Recall 16V-xxx. Please include copies of work order requests, invoices, and other documentation obtained regarding the specific repair.

The estimated time to repair is 1 hour.

What should you do?

Contact your local Moritz International Dealer from whom the trailer was purchased. The Dealer will schedule a time to have your trailer inspected and repaired.
