Possible Foreign Debris ISV Intake Tube, Allegro Breeze 32BR model years 2016 & 2017

Dear Tiffin Motorhome Owner,

For US Customers: This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Tiffin Motorhomes has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, could exist on the following models of motorhomes: **Allegro Breeze 32BR, model years 2016 & 2017**. Tiffin Motorhomes has become aware of the possibility that foreign debris may be in the tube that supplies fresh air to the engine. It is possible that this foreign debris could damage the air compressor. If the vehicle is unable to maintain air pressure while driving, the park brake may set leaving the vehicle unable to move, which could increase the risk of a vehicle crash.

Tiffin Motorhomes will arrange for inspections to be done on the engines in the possible affected units to see if any foreign debris is present. If foreign debris is found, the engine will need to be inspected for

any damage and repaired. Tiffin will arrange for the inspection and repair to be done by a Cummins certified technician. Engines with no damage will have a new air intake tube installed. Engines with foreign material damage will need to be repaired by a Cummins certified technician and have the air intake tube, charge air cooler and air filter replaced.

Advance arrangements are needed. Please contact Tiffin Motorhomes for these arrangements to be made. The inspection will take approximately 3 hours to complete, depending on the work needed. If damage is found, the repair may take up to 12 hours, depending on the work needed. This work will be performed at no charge to you the customer.
