Your Vehicle Identification Number (VIN):

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Ford Motor Company has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in your vehicle, with the VIN shown above.

We apologize for this situation and want to assure you that, with your assistance, we will correct this condition. Our commitment, together with your dealer, is to provide you with the highest level of service and support.

What is the issue?

On your vehicle, metallic debris from the diesel fuel injection pump can enter the fuel system. Depending on where the metallic debris collects in the fuel system, it may cause the fuel injectors to become clogged. If this occurs, the driver may experience a no-start condition or a stall without warning while driving and no restart capability, increasing the risk of a crash.

What will Ford and your dealer do?

Ford Motor Company has authorized your dealer to inspect the fuel system for metallic debris and replace the high pressure fuel pump. If metallic debris is found, your dealer is authorized to also replace all high pressure fuel system components and flush the low pressure fuel system to remove the contamination. This service will be performed free of charge (parts and labor).

How long will it take?

The time needed for this repair is less than 2 days. However, due to service scheduling requirements, your dealer may need your vehicle for a longer period of time. In addition, your vehicle will require an inspection to determine if additional parts need to be ordered.

What should you do?

Please call your dealer without delay and request a service date for Recall 16S32. Provide the dealer with your VIN, which is printed near your name at the beginning of this letter.

If you do not already have a servicing dealer, you can access www.Fordowner.com for dealer addresses, maps, and driving instructions. Ford Motor Company wants you to have this safety recall completed on your vehicle. The vehicle owner is responsible for making arrangements to have the work completed.

Please note: Federal law requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.

Your vehicle may be equipped with a diagnostic feature called the Vehicle Health Report which can inform you about all available recalls, as well as other key vehicle health information. Please see <https://owner.ford.com/vehicle-health> for more information.

Have you previously paid for this repair?

If you have previously paid for a repair that addresses the issue described in this letter, you still need to have this recall performed to ensure the correct parts were used.

You may be eligible for a refund of previously paid repairs. Refunds will only be provided for service related to fuel injection pump replacement. To verify eligibility and expedite reimbursement, give your paid original receipt to your dealer.

Refund requests may also be sent directly to Ford Motor Company. To request your refund from Ford, send the refund request with all required documentation, including your original repair receipt (no photocopies), to Ford Motor Company at P.O. Box 6251, Dearborn, Michigan 48121-6251. Refund requests mailed to this address may take up to 60 days to process. Your original receipt will be returned to you.
