IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Bison Coach (Bison) has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain Bison trailers. As a result, Bison is conducting a safety recall. We apologize for any inconvenience this action may cause you; however your safety and continued satisfaction are of the utmost importance to us.

***Reason for
this recall***

On certain travel trailers, a 30 amp fuse on the battery line was omitted at time of assembly. As a result, the circuit contains no overload protection. Should a short occur, wiring could overheat and cause a fire, which could increase the risk of injury and/or damage to property. Correction: Dealers will install a 30 amp inline fuse in the battery line."

***What we
will do***

Bison has contacted your selling dealer and has instructed them on how to install an inline fuse on the battery cable. This will be done at no cost to you the owner. The remedy should take approximately 30 minutes to perform.

***What we need
you to do***

At your earliest convenience, please contact your local dealer or local service provider and schedule an appointment to have this remedy completed. If you have questions concerning this recall or if you need any assistance, please contact the **Bison Warranty/Service Department** by mail at Bison, 1002 North Old State Rd. 15 Milford, IN 46542 or by phone at 574-658-4161.

If you had appropriate repairs completed prior to receipt of this recall notice, and if you incurred any direct cost in connection with obtaining such repair, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement from Bison by contacting the **Bison Warranty/Service Department**.
