Dear Peterbilt Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Peterbilt Motors Company has decided that certain Model Year 2017 Peterbilt Models 325, 330, 337, 348, 365, 367, 386, 389, and 587 vehicles manufactured April 20, 2016 to June 13, 2016 fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 108 (Lamps, Reflective Devices, and Associated Equipment). These vehicles may contain a defective stop light switch that does not meet Stop/Brake light requirements. The noncompliance may not exist in each vehicle. If the brake lights do not illuminate when the brakes are applied, other drivers will be unaware the vehicle is stopping, which can increase the risk of a crash.

<i>The problem is...</i>	Potentially defective stop light switch
<i>Correction...</i>	Dealer will inspect the stop light switch and remove and replace if defective
<i>What you must do ...</i>	Contact your Peterbilt dealer immediately to schedule an appointment

Peterbilt has initiated a recall to remedy the noncompliance free of charge. Please contact a Peterbilt dealership to schedule this repair. To find your nearest Peterbilt dealer, please visit Dealer Locator at www.Peterbilt.com. This repair should take approximately 0.5 hours Labor, and will be performed at no charge to you. If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.


