# Why is your vehicle being recalled?

The master cylinder brake lines may crack and develop a leak which may continue to worsen over time. Loss of brake fluid from one brake line may result in reduced vehicle braking performance, and a complete loss of brake fluid from both lines may result in a loss of braking capability. You may experience a soft brake pedal, and a telltale warning light will illuminate when the brake fluid is low. Vehicles with reduced braking performance may be at increased risk of a crash.

### What will we do?

Your GM dealer will replace the master cylinder brake lines. This service will be performed for you at **no charge**. Because of service scheduling requirements, it is likely that your dealer will need your vehicle longer than the actual service correction time of approximately 35 minutes.

## What should you do?

You should contact your GM dealer to arrange a service appointment as soon as possible.
